Imagination: Visions of What Might Be

The 2024 CSOTTE theme takes up the educational philosopher Maxine Greene’s emphasis on social imagination as “the capacity to invent visions of what should be and what might be in our deficient society, on the streets where we live, in our schools.” As educators of educators, a social imagination empowers us to reach towards others in a public space, achieving a community that is forever incomplete. Social imagination points us to the arts as a resource for seeing what we have not yet seen and for viewing unexpected possibilities as we imagine a transformative education of excellence for all of Texas’s more than 5.7 million students from many vibrant and diverse communities. Social imagination creates an opportunity for us, within the noble work of educator preparation, to remake through a healing vision “what it is that we may yet have in common” (Ahmed, 2000).

We welcome all proposals that add value to our work in preparing and developing educators! Preference will be given to proposals that address the theme of envisioning what might be as we contribute to societal needs. Proposals are considered in a double peer review process.

The CSOTTE Conference includes two programs: one for EPP professionals and another for EPP candidates. The call for Professional Program presentations is directed toward all teacher education practitioners. Breakout sessions are intended to disseminate practical and research practices and will identify a track and a target audience.

Proposals must include:

1. Speaker Information for each presenter (Maximum of 6 presenters per session)
 - Name
 - Job Title
 - EPP / School / Company Affiliation
 - Email & Phone Number
2. Submission Details
 - Title of Session
 - Track
 - Target Audience (faculty, EPP leadership, certification personnel, testing personnel, field placement personnel, EPP partners)
 - Presentation Format
 - Presentation Summary/Abstract (1500 characters limit)
 - Topic Keywords (up to three)
 - Presentation Proposal for the review process (5000 characters limit)

Presentation Formats:

1. **Single-Topic:** The single-topic presentation is focused on the speaker's/speakers' research or practice and engages participants in collaborative learning. The breakout session is provided in the 45-minute time allotment. A screen and projector will be provided. Presenters must bring a laptop/device.
2. **Multi-Topic:** The multi-topic presentation is designed for two presentations to be given within a 45-minute session. Each presentation group will be allotted approximately 20 minutes to share their research or practice and receive feedback on the work. A screen and projector will be provided. Presenters must bring a laptop/device.
3. **Round Table:** The round-table format includes multiple simultaneous small group (maximum of 8 participants) presentations offering informal discussion on specified topics. Round-table presenters facilitate discussion and may provide handouts but do not have access to a presentation screen. Therefore, PowerPoint-type presentations are **not** recommended. Participants may rotate through the varied round-table discussions in this 45-minute session.
