Call for Poster Session Proposals: Emerging Scholars & Emerging Professionals Track

## CSOTTE CONNECTS

Our 2025 CSOTTE Conference theme focuses on connection.

CSOTTE connects us to one another, our students, and the work we do to prepare exceptional teachers.

The Emerging Scholars & Professional Track is a one-day program held on **Monday, October 13<sup>th</sup>**, with a special registration rate of \$50.00. *Registration is required to attend.* Registrants have access to the Emerging Scholars & Professionals program. Those wanting to participate in the full conference offerings must select the Standard Professional registration. Poster session presentation is encouraged, but not required.

### **Emerging Scholars:**

Emerging Scholars are teacher candidates completing initial certification at the undergraduate or graduate level in a Texas Educator Preparation Program (EPP). Recent graduates (within the last academic year) are also welcome to participate if they are submitting a poster session proposal for projects completed during their initial certification preparation.

### **Emerging Professionals:**

Emerging Professionals are academic professionals completing a graduate or terminal degree in a Texas Educator Preparation Program (EPP). Graduate students are encouraged to submit a poster session proposal for projects completed during their graduate program.

### *Preparing the Proposal*

Poster Session proposals should be completed in a Word document and submitted to Alasdair Green at [agreen2@twu.edu](mailto:agreen2@twu.edu). Proposals may be submitted for single or multiple presenters and must include the following components.

1. For each presenter:
  - Name (as it should appear in the program)
  - Educator Preparation Program (EPP) / University Name & City
  - Email
  - Note the primary contact (if there are multiple presenters)
2. Title of Session
3. Abstract (100-word limit)
4. Summary of Project (300-word limit)
5. Sponsoring Faculty's name, institution, and email address
6. Sponsoring Faculty's signed letter of support for the project (attachment)
