



# Associate & Assistant Deans and Directors of Texas (ADoT) Colleges of Education

## Distinguished Service Award

### PURPOSE

The Distinguished Service Award has been established to recognize and further encourage the achievements and contributions of current or former Associate & Assistant Deans and Directors of Texas in the field of teacher preparation.

### THE AWARD

The award recipient will receive a commemorative plaque, lifetime membership. The recipient will also have their photo posted on the ADoT website along with comments from the nomination letters.

### ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must currently or formerly hold a position of Associate Dean, Assistant Dean, or Director within a Texas university-based educator preparation program. The nominee must have held one of the above positions, or a combination of positions for at least three years.

### NOMINATOR

To nominate someone for this award, you must be employed by a Texas university-based educator preparation program or Texas P-12 school.

### NOMINATION DOCUMENTATION

A statement of nomination must consist of no more than two pages that includes the nominee's name, position, place of employment, and contact information. It should also include a description of the nominee's experience as a mentor, their impact, and other details in support of their role as a mentor.

Two letters of support from peers, colleagues, supervisors, administrators, students, or other university community members who have knowledge of the nominee's mentoring practices. Evidence of the criteria described above must be included in the letters. The letters must also include details of the areas in which the nominee's performance has been outstanding.

All nominations should be submitted by September 1 through email to the ADoT President.

Award recipients will be selected by the ADoT Executive Council.
